

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### ENTRANTS

1. Entrants must be 18+, live in Western Australia and have an intellectual disability.

### ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

2. A maximum of one entry per entrant.
3. Artworks must be the entrant's original work and have been completed during the 12-month period prior to 16 September 2016.
4. Entries must not exceed 1 x 1 metres or 5 kilograms for 2D works, and 0.5 x 0.5 x 0.5 metres or 10 kilograms for 3D works.
5. Artworks must be ready for exhibition, that is framed with appropriate hanging arrangement. Failure to do so may result in a \$20 re-hanging fee or artwork not being displayed.
6. As We Are reserves the right to reject any entry if the number of entries received exceeds the capacity of the exhibition space and/or on the grounds that the material, subject or method of production is considered unsuitable.

### AWARD CATEGORIES

7. There are 7 art award categories each with a cash prize of \$500: Rosalind Lewis Award, David Guhl Award for Artistic Excellence, Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award, Aurenda Art Award, Replants Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Award, Jabula Farm Regional Art Award, and the Victoria Park Centre for the Arts People's Choice Award.
8. To enter the 'Replants Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Award,' entrants must be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander heritage.
9. To enter the 'Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award,' entries must be 3D.
10. To enter the 'Jabula Farm Regional Art Award' entrants must reside in regional Western Australia.

### ENTRY

11. All entrants must complete an entry form. Completed entry forms must be received by As We Are by 5pm Wednesday 31 August 2016. Entries can be submitted by email or post to As We Are. Incomplete or late entry forms will not be accepted.
12. An entry fee of \$10 (including GST) must accompany your entry form. This fee can be paid by cheque or money order made payable to the Nulsen Association, direct debit into the Nulsen Association bank account or via credit card. The entry fee is non-refundable under any circumstances, with the exception of entries not selected for exhibition whereby the entry fee will be returned.

### DELIVERY AND COLLECTION OF ARTWORK

13. Artwork must be delivered to the Victoria Park Centre for the Arts (12 Kent Street, East Victoria Park), 10am – 12pm, Friday 16 September 2016. Failure to deliver artworks during this time will result in works not being displayed.
14. Unsold artwork must be collected from Central Park Building Foyer (152-158 St Georges Terrace, Perth), 4pm – 6pm, Friday 7 October 2016. Due to a lack of storage space artworks not collected by this time will be charged a daily storage rate of \$10 per day.

### SALE OF ARTWORK

15. All entries are to be made available for sale-80% of sale retained by artists, 20% commission retained by As We Are. Entrants must recommend a sale price on their entry form above \$50 and inclusive of the 20% As We Are commission.
16. If your artwork is sold throughout the duration of the exhibition, As We Are will contact you by 7 October 2016.
17. Artists will receive payment, less commission, for any artworks sold by 25 November 2016. Proceeds from sales will be deposited directly into your nominated bank account.

### INSURANCE

18. Artworks will not be insured by As We Are. The organisers will take due care when handling and displaying artworks, however As We Are can accept no responsibility for damage to or loss of artworks through fire, accident, theft or vandalism. Artists are advised to provide their own insurance for artworks for the duration of the exhibition including transit to the Victoria Park Centre for the Arts (delivery venue) and from the Central Park Building Foyer (exhibition venue).

### JUDGING

19. As We Are will appoint an expert panel to judge the entries for all art award categories except the 'People's Choice Award'. Works will be judged according to artistic excellence. The 'Victoria Park Centre for the Arts People's Choice Award' will be judged by visitors to the exhibition. All entries will be judged.
20. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
21. Award winners will be announced at the Exhibition Opening and Award Presentation Night on Saturday 24 Saturday 2016, except the Victoria Park Centre for the Arts 'Victoria Park Centre for the Arts People's Choice Award' winner, who will be notified post-exhibition by Monday 17 October 2016.

### PUBLICITY AND PROMOTION

22. As We Are reserves the right to reproduce artworks, within reason, for promotional purposes. Appropriate acknowledgements will be made and Australian copyright laws will be observed. Copyright remains the property of the artist.

Please note artworks are limited in size and weight: 1m x 1m and up to 5kg for two-dimensional works, and 0.5m<sup>3</sup> and up to 10kg for three-dimensional works.

This year's exhibition is being held at the prestigious Central Park Building Foyer (152-158 St George's Terrace, Perth). Entrants and their family, friends and support network are highly encouraged to attend the exhibition opening night, whereby award winners will be announced.

There are seven art award categories, each with a corresponding cash prize of \$500:

- / **Rosalind Lewis Award**
- / **David Guhl Award For Artistic Excellence**
- / **Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award**  
(3D entries only)
- / **Aurenda Art Award**
- / **Replants Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Award**  
(Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander entrants only)
- / **Jabula Farm Regional Art Award**  
(Regional WA entrants only)
- / **Victoria Park Centre for the Arts People's Choice Award**

Entries will be judged by a professional, independent judging panel, except the People's Choice Award, which will be judged by visitors to the exhibition.

The judges will also award a number of Certificates of High Commendation for outstanding entries.

Regional, remote or rural entrants, please note that assistance (e.g. with framing, and the delivery and collection of artwork) is able to be provided. Please contact the Coordinator for further information.
