2013 marks the inaugural exhibition for Connecting Communities Kalamunda. This will be held in December to celebrate International Day of People with a Disability and Disability Awareness Week.

Artists are invited to submit one 2 dimensional piece of art work which will be given to a community artist to execute an artwork in any format they desire in response to the inspired 2D work. Both pieces of art will be exhibited together.

Submitting your Entry

Entry forms must be received by Connecting Communities Kalamunda by 5 p.m. Friday 26th July 2013 and must be accompanied with the photograph, profile and outline of the artist working on his/her artwork. Please note late entries will not be accepted.

Conditions of Entry

Entrants:

1. Entrants must be 18+, live in Western Australia and have an intellectual disability

Artwork Specifications:

2. Artwork must be the artist's original work and have been completed during the twelve month period prior to July 2013.
3. The artwork must be a 2 dimensional piece completed in a medium for example; acrylics, oil pastel, ink, pencils or mixed medium.
4. Dimensions of the artwork must not exceed 1m x 1m and weigh no more than 5 kg.
5. Artworks must be ready for exhibition, that is framed with appropriate hanging arrangement (e.g. properly affixed D hook-and-line). Failure to do so may result in the work not being displayed.
6. One piece of artwork per artist will be accepted.
7. Connecting Communities Kalamunda reserves the right to reject any entry if the number of entries received exceeds the capacity of the exhibition space and/or on the grounds that the material, subject or method of production is considered unsuitable for the purposes of presenting to a community artist for interpretation and the exhibition.

Entry:

8. All entrants must complete an entry form. Completed entry forms must be received by Connecting Communities Kalamunda no later than 5 p.m. Friday 26 July 2013. Entries can be submitted by email, post, in person or fax to Connecting Communities Kalamunda. No late entries will be accepted.
9. The artwork must be submitted with a photograph showing the artist working on the artwork together with a brief profile of the artist and an explanation of how the artist has achieved his/her work. Written material must be submitted in a typed format. The photograph and written submission will not be used for any other purpose than to submit it with the 2D artwork to the community artist.
10. If you are faxing your entry, a separate copy is to be emailed or posted to Connecting Communities Kalamunda, 28 Burton Street, Cannington WA 6107 Email: care@nulsen.com.au
11. The artwork must include an identification label on the back - refer to the cut out section of the entry form.

Delivery and Collection of Artwork:

12. Artwork must be delivered to the Zig Zag Cultural Centre, 50 Railway Road in Kalamunda on Monday 19 August from 1pm – 4pm. All artwork must be signed in. Failure to deliver and sign in artworks during the time will result in works not being displayed.
13. Unsold artwork must be collected from the Zig Zag Gallery Kalamunda, Railway Road, Kalamunda, 2 p.m. - 4 p.m. Sunday 15 December, 2013. Due to lack of storage space, artworks not collected by this time will be charged a daily storage rate of \$10.00 per day.

Sale of Artwork:

14. All entries are to be available for sale, with 30% commission going to the Zig Zag Gallery. Entrants must recommend a sale price inclusive of the 30% commission on their entry form.
15. If your artwork is sold throughout the duration of exhibition, Connecting Communities Kalamunda will contact you to let you know.
16. Artists will receive payment, less commission, for any artworks sold. Proceeds from sales will be deposited directly into your nominated bank account.

Insurance:

17. Artworks will not be insured by Connecting Communities Kalamunda or the Zig Zag Gallery. The organisers will take due care when handling and displaying artworks, however no responsibility for damage to, or loss of artworks through fire, accident, theft or vandalism will be accepted by Connecting Communities Kalamunda or the Zig Zag Gallery. Artists are advised to provide their own insurance for artworks for the duration of the exhibition including transit to and from the exhibition venue.

Publicity and Promotion:

18. Connecting Communities Kalamunda reserves the right to reproduce artworks within reason, for promotional purposes. Appropriate acknowledgements will be made and Australian copyright laws will be observed. Copyright remains the property of the artist.
