Entry form - Community Artists

2013 marks the inaugural exhibition for Connecting Communities Kalamunda. This will be held in December to celebrate International Day of People with a Disability and Disability Awareness Week.

Community artists are invited to submit one piece of art work, either a 2D or a 3D work in any art form, for example: painting, drawing, sculpture, textiles, print making, ceramic, jewellery, poetry or prose. The inspiration of the artwork is to be created in response to a 2D piece of art completed by a person with an intellectual disability and given to the community artist. Both pieces of art will be exhibited together.

Photography taken by the Kalamunda Senior High School students during the July workshops for artists with an intellectual disability will also be exhibited.

The exhibition will be held at the Kalamunda Zig Zag Gallery, Zig Zag Cultural Centre, Kalamunda. Entrants, family and sponsors are encouraged to attend the exhibition opening night to celebrate this special event.

Conditions of Entry

Entrants:

1. Entrants must be 18+, live in Western Australia and be a community or hobby artist

Artwork Specifications:

2. The artwork must be the artist's original work and have been completed as a work inspired by the submitted 2D piece of artwork completed by a person with an intellectual disability. The 2D artwork will include a photograph of the artist with an intellectual disability working on his/her artwork together with a written profile of the artist and an explanation of how the artist completed his/her submitted work
3. The community artist can submit a 2 or 3 dimensional piece completed in any art form, for example: painting / drawing / sculpture / textile / ceramic / jewellery. Alternatively it can be expressed in a written form of either poetry or a piece of prose, no more than 250 words
4. Dimensions of the artwork must not exceed 1m x 1m and weigh no more than 5 kg for a 2 dimensional art work or 0.5 x 0.5 x 0.5 metres and weigh no more than 15 kg for a 3 dimensional art work
5. Artworks must be ready for exhibition, that is framed with appropriate hanging arrangement (e.g. properly affixed D hook-and-line). Failure to do so may result in the work not being displayed
6. One piece of artwork per artist will be accepted
7. Connecting Communities Kalamunda reserves the right to reject any entry if the number of entries received exceeds the capacity of the exhibition space and/or on the grounds that the material, subject or method of production is considered unsuitable for the purposes of presenting to a community artist for interpretation and the exhibition

Entry:

8. All entrants must complete an entry form. Completed entry forms must be received by Connecting Communities Kalamunda no later than 5 p.m. Monday 16 August 2013. Entries can be submitted by email, post, in-person or fax to Connecting Communities Kalamunda. No late entries will be accepted
9. The artwork must be submitted with the formerly submitted 2D artwork
10. No entry fee will be required.

Delivery and Collection of Artwork:

11. The artwork package, completed by an artist with an intellectual disability must be collected at the Zig Zag Gallery, 50 Railway Road, Kalamunda on Tuesday 27 August from 1pm - 4pm. All artwork must be signed in. Completed works are to be delivered to the same location on Monday 28 October 2013 from 1pm - 4pm.
12. Unsold artwork must be collected from the Zig Zag Gallery Kalamunda, Railway Road, Kalamunda, 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday 15th December, 2013. Due to lack of storage space, artworks not collected by this time will be charged at a daily storage rate of \$10.00 per day

Sale of Artwork:

13. All entries are to be available for sale, with 30% commission going to the Zig Zag Gallery. Entrants must recommend a sale price inclusive of the 30% commission on their entry form.
14. If your artwork is sold throughout the duration of exhibition, Connecting Communities Kalamunda will contact you to let you know.
15. Artists will receive payment, less commission, for any artworks sold. Proceeds from sales will be deposited directly into your nominated bank account

Insurance:

16. Artworks will not be insured by Connecting Communities Kalamunda or the Zig Zag Gallery. The organisers will take due care when handling and displaying artworks, however no responsibility for damage to or loss of artworks through fire, accident, theft or vandalism will be accepted by Connecting Communities Kalamunda or the Zig Zag Gallery. Artists are advised to provide their own insurance for artworks for the duration of the exhibition including transit to and from the exhibition venue.

Publicity and Promotion:

17. Connecting Communities Kalamunda reserves the right to reproduce artworks within reason, for promotional purposes. Appropriate acknowledgements will be made and Australian copyright laws will be observed. Copyright remains the property of the artist.
