

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRANTS

1. Entrants must be 18+, live in Western Australia and have an intellectual disability.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

2. Artworks must be the artist's original work and have been completed during the twelve-month period prior to Monday 27th October 2014.
3. The dimensions of entries must not exceed 1 x 1 metres for two-dimensional works, and 0.5x0.5x0.5 metres for three-dimensional works.
4. The weight of entries must not exceed 5 kilograms for two-dimensional works and 10 kilograms for three-dimensional works.
5. Artworks must be ready for exhibition, that is framed with appropriate hanging arrangement (e.g. properly affixed hook-and-line method or fixed hanging point that is able to hold weight of work). Failure to do so may result in a \$20 re-hanging fee or artwork not being displayed.
6. A maximum of two entries or artworks per artist will be accepted.
7. As We Are reserves the right to reject any entry if the number of entries received exceeds the capacity of the exhibition space and/or on the grounds that the material, subject or method of production is considered unsuitable for the purposes of the Act-Belong-Commit 2014 As We Are Art Award.

AWARD CATEGORIES

8. There are six award categories each with a cash prize of \$500: Rosalind Lewis Award, David Guhl Award for Artistic Excellence, Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award, Aurenda Art Award, Nulsen Reconciliation Action Plan Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Award and the People's Choice Award.
9. To enter the 'Nulsen Reconciliation Action Plan Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Award,' entrants must be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander heritage.
10. To enter the 'Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award,' entries must be three-dimensional

ENTRY

11. All entrants must complete an entry form. Completed entry forms must be received by As We Are by 5pm Friday 3rd October 2014. Entries can be submitted by email, post or fax to As We Are. Incomplete or late entry forms will not be accepted
12. An entry fee of \$10 for one entry or \$15 for two entries (including GST) must accompany your entry form. This fee can be paid by cheque or money order made payable to the Nulsen Association, direct debit into the Nulsen Association bank account or via credit card. The entry fee is non-refundable under any circumstances, with the exception of entries not selected for exhibition whereby the entry fee will be returned.

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION OF ARTWORK

13. Artwork must be delivered to the Victoria Park Centre for the Arts (12 Kent Street, East Victoria Park), 10am-12pm, Monday 27th October 2014. All artwork must be signed in. Failure to deliver and sign in artworks during this time will result in works not being displayed.
14. Unsold artwork must be collected from Central Park Building Foyer (152-158 St Georges Terrace, Perth), 4pm-6pm, Friday 14th November 2014. Due to a lack of storage space, artworks not collected by this time will be charged a daily storage rate of \$10 per day.

SALE OF ARTWORK

15. All entries are to be made available for sale -85% of sale retained by artists, 15% commission retained by As We Are. Entrants must recommend a sale price above \$50 and inclusive of the 15% As We Are commission on their entry form for each entry.
16. If your artwork is sold throughout the duration of the exhibition, As We Are will contact you by 14th November 2014.
17. Artists will receive payment, less commission, for any artworks sold by 22nd December 2014. Proceeds from sales will be deposited directly into your nominated bank account.

INSURANCE

18. Artworks will not be insured by As We Are. The organisers will take due care when handling and displaying artworks, however As We Are can accept no responsibility for damage to or loss of artworks through fire, accident, theft or vandalism. Artists are advised to provide their own insurance for artworks for the duration of the exhibition including transit to the Victoria Park Centre for the Arts (delivery venue) and from the Central Park Building Foyer (exhibition venue).

JUDGING

19. As We Are will appoint a panel of judges to judge the artworks for all award categories except the 'People's Choice Award'. Works will be judged according to artistic excellence. The 'People's Choice Award' will be judged by visitors to the exhibition. All entries will be judged.
20. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
21. Award winners will be announced at the Exhibition Opening and Award Presentation Night on Saturday 1st November 2014, except the 'People's Choice Award' winner.
22. The 'People's Choice Award' winner will be notified by Monday 24th November 2014.

PUBLICITY AND PROMOTION

23. As We Are reserves the right to reproduce artworks, within reason, for promotional purposes. Appropriate acknowledgements will be made and Australian copyright laws will be observed. Copyright remains the property of the artist.

In 2014, artists (aged 18+) are invited to submit up to two artworks, either 2- or 3-dimensional, in any art form, for example: Painting / Drawing / Sculpture / Textiles / Print-making / Ceramic / Jewellery.

Please note artworks are limited in size and weight: 1m x 1m and up to 5kg for two-dimensional works, and 0.5m³ and up to 10kg for three-dimensional works.

This year's exhibition is being held at the prestigious Central Park Building Foyer (152-158 St George's Terrace, Perth). Entrants and their family, friends and support network are highly encouraged to attend the exhibition opening night, whereby award winners will be announced.

There are six art award categories, each with a corresponding cash prize of \$500:

- / ROSALIND LEWIS AWARD
- / DAVID GUHL AWARD FOR ARTISTIC EXCELLENCE
- / STEPHEN DELOWER MEMORIAL 3D AWARD (3D entries only)
- / AURENDA ART AWARD
- / NULSEN RECONCILIATION ACTION PLAN ABORIGINAL & TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER AWARD (Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander entrants only)
- / PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD

Entries will be judged by a professional, independent judging panel, except the People's Choice Award, which will be judged by visitors to the exhibition.

The judges will also award a number of Certificates of High Commendation for outstanding entries.

Regional, remote or rural entrants, please note that assistance (e.g. with framing, and the delivery and collection of artwork) is able to be provided. Please contact the Coordinator for further information.
