

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ENTRANTS

1. Entrants must be 18+, live in Western Australia and have an intellectual disability.

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

2. A maximum of one entry per entrant.
3. Artworks must be the entrant's original work and have been completed during the 12-month period prior to 4 November 2020.
4. Entries must not exceed 1 x 1 metres or 5 kilograms for 2D works, and 0.5 x 0.5 x 0.5 metres or 10 kilograms for 3D works.
5. Artworks must be ready for exhibition, that is framed with appropriate hanging arrangement. Failure to do so may result in artwork not being displayed.
6. As We Are reserves the right to reject any entry if the number of entries received exceeds the capacity of the exhibition space and/or on the grounds that the material, subject or method of production is considered unsuitable.

AWARD CATEGORIES

7. There are seven art award categories each with a cash prize of \$500: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Award, Contemporary Art Award, David Guhl Award for Artistic Excellence, People's Choice Award, Regional Art Award, Rosalind Lewis Award, and the Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award.
8. To enter the 'Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Award,' entrants must be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander heritage.
9. To enter the 'Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award,' entries must be 3D.
10. To enter the 'Regional Art Award' entrants must reside in regional Western Australia.

ENTRY

11. All entrants must complete an entry form. Completed entry forms must be received by As We Are by 5pm Friday 9th October 2020. Entries can be submitted by email or post. Incomplete or late entry forms will not be accepted.
12. An entry fee of \$10 (including GST) must accompany your entry form. This fee can be paid by cheque or money order made payable to the Nulsen Group Inc, direct debit into the Nulsen Group bank account, or via credit card. The entry fee is non-refundable under any circumstances, with the exception of entries not selected for exhibition whereby the entry fee will be returned.

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION OF ARTWORK

13. Artwork must be delivered to the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre (Level 2 Main Foyer, 21 Mounts Bay Road, Perth), 10am–12pm, Wednesday 4th November 2020. Failure to deliver artworks during this time will result in works not being displayed.
14. Unsold artwork must be collected from Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre (Level 2, Main Foyer, 21 Mounts Bay Road), 4–6pm Sunday 22nd OR 10am–12pm Monday 23rd November 2020.

SALE OF ARTWORK

15. All entries are to be made available for sale - 80% of sale retained by artist, 20% commission retained by As We Are. Entrants must recommend a sale price on their entry form above \$50 and inclusive of the 20% As We Are commission.
16. If your artwork is sold throughout the duration of the exhibition, As We Are will contact you by the 22nd November 2020.
17. Artists will receive payment, less commission, for any artworks sold by 24th December 2020. Proceeds from sales will be deposited directly into your nominated bank account.

INSURANCE

18. Artworks will not be insured by As We Are. The organisers will take due care when handling and displaying artworks, however As We Are cannot accept any responsibility for damage to or loss of artworks through fire, accident, theft or vandalism. Artists are advised to provide their own insurance for artworks for the duration of the exhibition including transit to and from the Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre.

JUDGING

19. As We Are will appoint an expert panel to judge the entries for all art award categories except the 'People's Choice Award'. Works will be judged according to artistic excellence. The 'People's Choice Award' will be judged by visitors to the exhibition. All entries will be judged.
20. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
21. Award winners will be announced at the Exhibition Opening and Award Presentation Night (date to be confirmed), except the 'People's Choice Award' winner, who will be notified post-exhibition by Friday 27th November 2020.

PUBLICITY AND PROMOTION

22. As We Are reserves the right to reproduce artworks, within reason, for promotional purposes. Appropriate acknowledgments will be made and Australian copyright laws will be observed. Copyright remains the property of the artist.

2020 AS WE ARE ART AWARD INVITATION TO ENTER & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

NOW IN ITS 18TH YEAR, THE AS WE ARE ART AWARD IS WA'S PREMIER EXHIBITION SHOWCASING WESTERN AUSTRALIAN ARTISTS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY.

In 2020, artists (aged 18+) are invited to submit one artwork, either 2- or 3- dimensional, in any art form, for example: Painting / Drawing / Sculpture / Textiles / Print-making / Ceramic / Jewellery.

Please note artworks are limited in size and weight: 1m x 1m and up to 5kg for two-dimensional works, and 0.5m³ and up to 10kg for three-dimensional works.

This year's exhibition is being held at the prestigious Perth Convention and Exhibition Centre (21 Mounts Bay Road, Perth).

There are seven art award categories, each with a corresponding cash prize of \$500:

- / Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Award (Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander entrants only)
- / Contemporary Art Award
- / David Guhl Award For Artistic Excellence
- / People's Choice Award
- / Regional Art Award (regional WA entrants only)
- / Rosalind Lewis Award
- / Stephen Delower Memorial 3D Award (3D entries only)

The judges will also award a number of Certificates of High Commendation for outstanding entries. Entries will be judged by a professional, independent judging panel, except the People's Choice Award, which will be judged by visitors.
